- Day VIII: Musical note VIII
- Day IX: Musical note IX
- Day X: Musical note X
- Day XI: Musical note XI
- Day XII: Musical note XII

Snowflakes are placed in the following positions:

- Between I and II
- Between II and III
- Between III and IV
- Between IV and V
- Between V and VI
- Between VI and VII
- Between VII and VIII
- Between VIII and IX
- Between IX and X
- Between X and XI
- Between XI and XII
